This should be a fun trip as the Troop has not gone camping at this location for a number of years. This campground offers fishing, boat rentals, swimming at the campground's pools, and hot showers. The campground also offers RV camping but personal arrangements must be made for reservations and paying fees. See Ron Brisson for the contacting Lake Cachuma.

This adventure is open to all family members and alumni of Troop 212 but minor family members must be accompanied by a parent. Troop permission slips will be required for all minors on the trip.

Departure: Friday, September 10th at 7:00 PM – Church parking lot. Please arrive promptly for check in.

Families may leave earlier/later than the troop but please inform Ron of your arrival time/date at the

sign in.

Return Arrival: Sunday, September 12th, at approximately 3:30 PM – Church parking lot.

Trip Destination: Lake Cachuma, Santa Barbara County Park

Cost: \$30.00 / \$15.00 The \$15 cost for gas is for those who will be departing with the troop and a parent

is not attending/driving on the trip. The \$15 gas fee is waived for scouts if the parent is driving them to/from Lake Cachuma. Please bring cash to the troop meeting on Monday, August 30th, with the

standard permission slip which can be found on the Troop's website.

Uniform: Full uniform for travel Friday evening and Sunday's trip home.

<u>Patrol Style Cooking-</u> We will be eating Patrol style on this trip. Patrols will be required to prepare their menus and food shop as normal. All others will be eating with the Badger Patrol unless they wish to eat on their own or in their own RV. Please inform the trip leader, Ron Brisson of this when you sign up for the trip.

<u>Swimming –</u> There is no swimming in Lake Cachuma as it is a fresh water reservoir for Santa Barbara. However, there is a campground pool where everyone can swim. Please bring a towel and a bathing suit as cut-off jeans may not be allowed.

Equipment – All who wish to fish must bring their own fishing gear. Everyone 16 years or older must have a California fishing license. We will be fishing for bass and trout. All family members wishing to join on the trip must supply their own camping gear such as tents, sleeping bags, eating utensils/plates/cups.
