
T-212 SMT Backpack Qualification Hike

- 1. Please stay on the trails at all times. Every year some of our plants are damaged or killed by accidental trampling. We know how tempting it is to get a closer look at that perfect flower, or set up a better camera range, but we must ask that you stay on the public path at all times.
- 2. No collecting. Please take only memories and leave only footprints.
- 3. Please do not feed the wildlife. The Nature Center area has been allowed to balance itself so none of the wildlife is dependent upon people for any type of food. Please don't upset that balance.
- 4. Leave any food or beverages in your car or bus; eating in the Nature Center is not allowed. Visitors can bring water in non-disposable water bottles only.
- 5. Remain quiet. Not only will you be able to see more animals, but you will allow others to enjoy the solitude of the Center's trails.
- 6. Sorry, no pets on the Nature Center grounds. Domesticated animals wreak havoc with the instincts of wildlife.
- 7. Please do not smoke. Even a small accident would mean a huge loss.
- 8. Bike riding and jogging are not allowed. The trails were not constructed for these purposes.
- 9. Pond areas are for birds, fish and reptiles. No fishing, swimming, wading or boating is allowed.
- 10. If needed, please use the restrooms at the end of the parking lot located outside the fenced Nature Center grounds, before your tour begins.
- 11. Parks, Recreation and Marine Department policies and regulations, as well as city, state, and federal statutes and ordinances must be adhered to.
- 12. Breakage or damage of equipment must be paid for at the cost determined by the Department of Parks, Recreation and Marine.
- 13. Under no circumstances will any group make any structural or electrical alterations in building and grounds, except by written permission of the Director of Parks, Recreation and Marine.
- 14. Any organization which abuses the privilege of using a building, facility, or equipment will be deprived of current and future use.
- 15. Permit and tour fees are separate of vehicle entry fee.
