Motion sickness medicine suggested (i.e. Dramamine, Bonine) taken prior to departure. Money – galley will be open. We need to meet a \$250 minimum galley fee. No coolers or ice chests allowed aboard the vessel. See troop website trips section for the menu.

badge. This is by appointment only so please contact him (refer to the ScoutTrack
