Overview & Required Forms

**NOTICE: IMPORTANT NEW INFORMATION,
PLEASE READ COMPLETELY!**

Greeting to all, here's a review of information & directions to get signed up for this year's family Snow Sports day @ SNOW SUMMIT. This is a family event so all are welcome.

New for this year: Helmets are Mandatory for all Scouts per the Guide to Safe Scouting (revision date 08/19/2009) and the rule does not extend to parents or other family members. Snow Summit does not rent helmets so additional information will be handed out at Monday meetings including options to help you source a helmet for your Scout if you do not already have one.

Please note: The troop will not be sourcing helmets for this trip and they are not included in the Summit mountain equipment rental package. The info below should assist you in this area.

Highly recommended: that New Boarders and Skiers take lessons. The price is right and it's a safe way to learn with trained instructors.

What do you need to do?

- 1) **Secure a helmet:** As stated, each Scout needs to bring a snow sport helmet for this event and this requirement is mandatory for the Scout only. Further, this rule does not extend to parents or other family members. See supplemental helmet information posted on the trip section of the web page for information on sourcing options.
- 2) **Troop212 Permission Slip:** Fill out completely ONE per Scout.
- 3) **Release Waivers:** Group Ticket & Lesson Release Waiver: Fill out completely ONE per person including Scouts, Adults, family members, and siblings. Parent or guardian must sign for minor. This waiver is required for every participant who purchases a Group Ticket!
- 4) **Rental Forms:** for those who need equipment (2 pages Detail and Summary page).
 - a) Fill out the Detail page completely ONE for each person (renter).
 - b) Add all people to your group on the Summary information page.
 - c) Rental forms are to be kept by individuals and submitted to Snow Summit at time of rental. However, if you provide a copy to the trip Coordinator along with your payment, we will try to have your information entered into Snow Summit's computer for faster on hill processing when you check in.
 - d) You will be required to purchase a damage waiver for each set of equipment rented.
- 5) **Payment Schedule:** Review the cost schedule and select the package(s) for your self or your family. Please check the total on your cost schedule form matches the payment you submit. Please remember to include the mandatory damage waiver cost for each set of equipment rented.

- 6) **Submit;** Completed forms and payments to Randy Galisky at the troop meeting on ~~MONDAY, JANUARY 25, 2010.~~ Deadline extended to Feb 1, 2010. This is the last chance to sign up!

This event starts at the hill and participants need to arrange transportation to and from the event. If you need help arranging a ride to the event, please let us know and we can try to help you. Directions along with any other mountain info, including additional forms if needed, are available @ the SNOW SUMMIT web site www.bigbearmountainresorts.com.

As soon as you arrive please check in with the scout troop. The meeting location will be on the top deck of the Bear Bottom Lodge located at the bottom of chair 2.

Snow Sports Merit Badge; testing is available. Scouts need to check in at 1:00 pm at the meet location to demonstrate skill proficiency with Merit Badge Counselor John Douglas.
