Troop 212 Fishing Trip at Silverwood Lake

Dear Scouts and Scouters,

Troop 212 will be camping and fresh water fishing at Silverwood Lake (alt 3,380 ft) located off Highway 138, 11 miles east of the I-15 weekend of May 20-22. This campground offers fishing, boat rentals, hiking and swimming. The lake has a surface area of 976 acres and has 13 miles of shoreline. Fishing is excellent at Silverwood Lake. Anglers 16 years of age or older must purchase a California Department of Fish&Game fishing license. Regular trout plants take place throughout the year by the California Department of Fish and Game. Other species of fish include Largemouth Bass, Striper Bass, Crappie, Bluegill and Channel Catfish which bite throughout the year. You can fish from the dock for a fee of \$3 for those 16 and older, \$2.00 for those under 16. Boat rentals are available from the marina (\$100 deposit, \$78.00 for the day). Boats hold a maximum of 4 persons. Adults who rent boats must follow two deep leadership if they have scouts other than their scouts in the boat and completed safety afloat. Fishing pole construction and fly fishing instruction will be offered. Scouts are encouraged to earn their fishing merit badge. There will be a casting a contest as well as a tent inspection for the scouts. See the troop web site for tent judging criteria. <u>http://www.troop212.net/resources/forms/</u>. We are also planning a geocaching activity. Scouts are encouraged to bring their GPS gear. <u>This trip is not family camp. Family camp is the August Beach trip.</u>
