

Troop 212 Ocean Fishing – July 2011

Dear Scouts and Scouters,

This year we will be going out of Newport Harbor on a scheduled vessel. The boats from this landing often return with a large assortment of types of fish caught.

Departure: **Saturday, July 2nd at 6:30 PM** – Davey’s Locker 400 Main St. Newport Beach. Parking is in two structures on Main Street (\$8 if you forget to get it validated.) Do not park on the street because the meters are limited to 2 hours and you will get a ticket. Check the website below for maps. Please arrange your own transportation and arrive promptly. If you are renting gear and/or purchasing a license (required for ages 16 and over) please be early (5:30) and complete your transactions before departure time. **The boat will leave promptly.** Do not be late. This Vessel is not chartered to Troop 212 and it will run on schedule. DO NOT MISS THE BOAT!

Return: **Saturday, July 2nd, at approximately Midnight** – Boat returns to same dock it departed from.

Cost: **\$40.00** (1 passage fee, patch, prizes, gunny sack and tip). **All money is due on Monday, June 27th, along with the standard permission slip,** which can be found on the website.

Optional cost *Rod rental –(free with tackle) Tackle - \$8 fish cleaning \$1/fish One-day license - \$14.04 Boat Jackpot is typically \$5 to enter.*

Please notify Tommy by Monday, June 27th, if you need gear and tackle.

Preparation: Ocean fishing rigging demo - troop meeting, Monday, June 27th.

Uniform: Class B. Class A uniforms will not be required on this trip.

Bring: Gear, if not renting.
Warm clothes. It gets very cold on the water at night.
Motion sickness medicine (e.g. Dramamine) taken prior to departure.
Money – for food (galley will be open) and fish cleaning service.

Merit Badge: Tommy Dyo will be at the dock at 3:00 pm for those interested in working on the Fishing merit badge. This is by appointment only so please contact him (refer to the ScoutTrack directory) by June 27th if you are interested.

Prizes: Prize categories to be announced as we set sail.
