The camp requirement for the family dog is that it must be on a leash at all times and is not allowed in a public food area.

This adventure is open to all family members and alumni of Troop 212, but minor family members must be accompanied by a parent. If any scout wants to attend this adventure, but does not have their family camping with them, he may still attend by joining with another family, or camping family style with the Scoutmaster by using troop and patrol equipment.
