This year we will be going out of Long Beach Marina Sport Fishing, Alamitos Bay, on a scheduled vessel. **This trip is open to scouts, family members, alumni, and friends.** This will be an exciting night-time ocean fishing trip.

- Arrive: Arrive at the Landing **no later** than 6:00 pm if you have all of your gear and license. Arrive no later than 5:30 pm if you are renting or need a license.
- **Departure:** Friday, August 2nd at 6:30 PM Long Beach Marina Sport Fishing, 180 Marina Drive, Long Beach. This is the marina on Alamitos Bay where Khoury's restaurant is located. Parking is \$5, but will be free if the booth is unoccupied. Check the website below for maps. Please arrange your own transportation and arrive promptly. If you are renting gear and/or purchasing a license (required for ages 16 and over) please be early (5:30) and complete your transactions before departure time. <u>The boat will leave promptly</u>. This Vessel is not chartered to Troop 212 and it will run on schedule. DON'T MISS THE BOAT!
- **Return:** <u>Friday, August 2nd, at approximately Midnight</u> Boat returns to same dock from which it departed. We plan to activate SPOT for this outing.

- Cost: <u>\$42.00</u> (1 passage fee, patch, prizes, gunny sack and tip). <u>All money is due on Monday,</u> July 22th, along with the standard permission slip, which can be found on the website.
- Optional cost Rod rental -\$15 (Deposit CA driver's license or credit card no charge unless equipment is lost or damaged) Fish cleaning \$1/fish One-day license \$14 Boat Jackpot is typically \$5 to enter. Please assist your scout with rod rental and deposit even if you are not going. Rod and Gear rental is your responsibility.

Please notify Shawn or Gary by Monday, July 22nd, to reserve rented tackle.

- **Preparation:** Ocean fishing rigging demo troop meeting, Monday, July 22th. We will raffle off some gear this night to those who are going on the trip! We will have a fresh water demo on July 29th.
- **Uniform:** <u>Class B</u>. Class A uniforms will not be required on this trip.
- Bring:Gear, if not renting. (Consider, 50 to 100 ft deep) rod, reel, hooks, weights, and a cooler.
Warm clothes. It gets very cold on the water at night.
Motion sickness medicine (e.g. Dramamine) taken prior to departure.
Money for Rod rental (if needed), food (galley will be open) and fish cleaning service.

Prizes: Prize categories to be announced as we set sail.
