Departure from LB:	Friday, 10/20/23 to meet at 7:00 PM, our Church parking lot. We will depart at 7:30 PM SHARP.
Travel:	There will be one short restrooms and fuel stop Friday night. This is not a dinner stop. Please eat dinner at home before
	arriving at the Church parking lot.
Return to LB:	Sunday, 10/22/22 around 5:30PM – Church parking lot. Check SPOT for updates.
Cost:	<u>\$90.00 per person for shooters,10-17-23, (</u> , \$40.00 for non-shooters . (50 ammo/20 food/ 10 trailer fuel, 10 storage equipment fee)
Gas money:	<u>General gas money will not be collected</u> . If your scout is riding with another adult, please give that driver \$15-\$20 for gas
Permission Slip:	California has very restrictive shooting laws concerning minors and the use and handling of firearms and ammunition. Because of this, we need a complete parental consent. Circle and sign/initial the appropriate spots on the permission slip.
Documents:	<u>Please print 2 copies of the PERMISSION SLIP.</u> One copy your scout must turn in with payment on Monday 10/17/22the other belongs in the scouts pocket for the duration of the trip while shooting. State police may be by.
Program Materials:	We need folding tables, table blankets, chairs, and popup shade easy up canopies in the shooting stations,
Safety Training:	MANDATORY Safety Training Monday Sept 25, Monday Oct 2, and mandatory final exam Monday, Oct 9 th . All registered scouts may attend this camping trip, but only those firearm safety qualified are allowed to shoot. Scouts must have attended these required training sessions and successfully completed the Safety Test. There is a makeup test session on Tuesday, Oct 10, at 6 PM for some scouts that are invited, based on the level the scout achieves on the first test. Scouts and adults must meet all California safety requirements to shoot.
Food Shop:	<u>Thursday, 10/19/22, 7:00 PM</u> at Stater Brothers.
Uniform:	Class A uniform during auto travel on Friday and Sunday (not Thursday food shopping).
Sunday Lunch:	Bring extra money for our traditional lunch stop.
Camp Fire:	Please bring firewood from home for this.
Firearms:	We need to borrow from our scouting families some 22 cal rifles, 12 G and 20 G shotguns
Firearms Policy:	Scouts are not allowed to transport their own firearm. If a scout wishes to bring his own firearm, and
	has no parent taking responsibility for that firearm, it must be checked in with the Scoutmaster or his designated
	Assistant Friday evening during vehicle loading. Please put your name on the firearm, magazine (if applicable) and its case.

Two troop 5 gallon water jugs will be distributed to each attending family at the troop meeting on 10/17/22. Please fill them up at home on the Friday of our departure. We also need everyone to bring their own cooler full of ice for troop and patrol use. All adult gear needs to be marked with family name for ensured return.
